

Biosecurity for New Arrivals on a Yard

Prevent the Spread of Disease Between Horses

Vaccination

Flu and tetanus

Equine Herpes Virus
advised for breeding stock
AND
should be considered in yards where there are travelling competition horses

Worms



Check history



If not available perform tests



Isolate

for a minimum of 14 days, ideally 28 days



Stable as far away as possible from the other horses



Double fencing to separate when turned out



Separate equipment and tack



People



Don't touch other people's horses or equipment



Wash hands and boots after handling/being in stable



Do the isolating horse after the other horses



Monitor



Monitor temp twice daily



Monitor for coughing, snot, enlarged lymph nodes, being off-colour, etc



Call vet immediately if any concerns

Discuss with your vet for a tailored approach to biosecurity for your yard
