

TACK ROOM BIOSECURITY CHECKLIST



Daily Tasks

- Clean tack after every use (bridles, bits, girths, saddles)
 - Disinfect shared equipment between horses
- Check foot mat/dip is clean and topped up with disinfectant
 - Wipe down door handles and high-touch areas
 - Check for signs of pests (mice, rodents, flies)

Weekly Tasks

- Clean and disinfect boots, grooming kits, numnahs, girths and tack.
 - Sweep and disinfect floors
 - Air out the tack room to prevent damp
 - Check ventilation is working properly
 - Refill hand sanitiser/disinfectant supplies

Monthly Tasks

- Deep clean entire tack room (walls, shelves, hooks)
- Review tack and tools for damage or contamination
 - Re-stock disinfectants (DEFRA-approved only)
- Keep records up to date label or assign tack if needed



Horse Equipment Protocol

- Each horse has separate tack & grooming tools
- No sharing of bits, girths, numnahs unless disinfected
- Trial or visiting horses have labelled tack/equipment
- All visiting horse equipment kept out of main tack room

People Protocol

- Foot dips/mats used by all entering tack room
 - No unauthorised access to tack room
- Hand sanitiser used before and after handling equipment
 - Visitors briefed on biosecurity rules

People Protocol

- Suspected horses are isolated
- Their equipment is clearly marked and kept separate
 - Disinfect all surfaces they may have contacted
 - Log the incident in biosecurity book
